- Please arrive 15 minutes prior to tour to check-in.
- Adult:Child ratio guidelines for your group are 1:5 for children under age 10, 1:10 for children 10 and up.
- A parent or guardian must complete a permission form for each child attending the tour (attached).
- Adults, please bring a state issued photo-ID when you come to Haven for Hope. Security is a priority for us and we do not permit convicted sex offenders to volunteer or visit our campus. Accordingly, Haven for Hope will check all visitor and guest IDs against sex offender registries. We appreciate your understanding for this policy.
- Out of respect for our members and volunteers, please notify us of any changes to the group size or group's ages as soon as possible and of any cancellations at least two business days in advance.
- Groups arriving 30 minutes after their scheduled time are not guaranteed a tour and will be asked to reschedule.
- The identity of our clients, and or treatment received at Haven for Hope or by any of its providing partners is confidential and may not be disclosed by any person having knowledge of such information.
- To respect our client's privacy, pictures of our clients are strictly prohibited without written consent from Haven for Hope.
- Attire: Please make sure to dress comfortably and in accordance with our dress code (no spaghetti strap shirts, tanks, shorts/skirts shorter than knee length, shirts shorter than waist length or pants below the waist). Walking shoes and bottled water are recommended.
